DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY

Boamah-Abu, Charles Thesis Title: A sequential explanatory mixed methods investigation of e-government outcomes evaluation practice in developing countries: South Africa as context

Charles Boamah-Abu completed a BScHons (Computer Science) at Rhodes University and an MCom in Information Systems at UCT. His interests in computing span software development, human-computer interaction, and IT management. Hehas worked as an industry consultant and taught at universities.

Charles Boamah-Abu's thesis focuses on e-government outcomes evaluation practice in developing countries, with South Africa as context. He adopts Schatzki's site ontology to investigate the practice of public employees drawn from Evaluation, Information Technology, and other backgrounds. He applies quantitative methods to identify the main elements of e-government outcomes evaluation and the different patterns of performance. He further employs qualitative methods to examine these results. The evidence drawn from the two phases shows an inadequate internal organisational capacity to conduct such evaluations and use the results for improvement. He identifies aspects of current practice which need improvement and develops recommendations which target respective stakeholders to advance e-government outcomes evaluation.

Chemisto, Musa Satya
Thesis Title: Optimizing perspectives:
a classic grounded theory of
stakeholder perceptions on WSDB
influence in Uganda's water sector

Musa Chemisto holds BSc and MSc Computer Science degrees from the Islamic University in Uganda and Islamic University of Technology, Bangladesh. He joined UCT in 2014 for his PhD studies with iCOMMS research group. He works as an IT Director and Lecturer at the Islamic University in Uganda.

Musa Chemisto's thesis focuses on developing a new theory regarding the influence of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) on Uganda's water sector development. He investigates the impact of the Water Supply Database (WSDB), implemented by Uganda's Ministry of Water and Environment (MWE) to support governance. Adopting Classic Grounded Theory (CGT) methodology allowed him to propose a conceptual theory based on data collected from multiple stakeholders. The theory connotes constructs which infer continual WSDB optimisation by the MWE to improve citizen's access to water country-wide. His findings contribute firstly to ICT for Development (ICT4D) or Information Systems in Developing Countries (ISDC) research which examines the development-oriented significance of ICT. Secondly, is the findings are useful for understanding the implications of adopting CGT for ICT4D research in Sub-Saharan Africa. Finally, his theory provides concepts and guidelines which inform social-technical analysis in Information Systems research, and future rational design of new substantive theories.

Kemp, Esti Thesis Title: *Non-bank financial intermediation – a focus on South Africa*

Esti Kemp completed her BCom and BCom (Hons) qualifications at the University of Pretoria, and began her PhD on a part-time basis at UCT in 2016. She was employed at the South African Reserve Bank for roughly eight years before joining the Financial Stability Board in 2018.

Esti Kemp's thesis sheds light on the non-bank financial intermediation sector in South Africa - also known as the shadow banking industry. She sets out to measure its components over time and its interconnectedness with the banking sector. She finds that growth of non-bank financial intermediaries in South Africa outpaced that of banks after the 2008 financial crisis. She also finds significant links between banks and investment funds - in particular money-market funds. Using detailed data on investment fund holdings, she proposes a method to compute losses to the financial system as a result of a failure of the banks based on look-through exposures. She shows that the traditional financial cycle for South Africa has a longer duration and larger amplitude than the business cycle. She also finds that the cyclical properties of non-bank credit cycles differ from those of bank credit Her findings emphasise the importance of monitoring non-bank credit.

Ongudi, Silas Okech Thesis Title: Social safety nets in presence of weather shocks: three essays on development economics from village economies in Kenya

Silas Ongudi holds BSc and MSc degrees in Agricultural Economics from Egerton University, Kenya. He joined the School of Economics at UCT in 2016 for his PhD studies.

Silas Ongudi's thesis analyses how social safety nets can be used as a policy instrument to cushion poor households from weather-induced vulnerabilities. Using a unique randomised controlled trail dataset from the Hunger Safety Net Programme (HSNP) conducted between 2010 and 2012, he shows that the effects of drought-induced weather shocks are large, particularly during the early stage of a child's life and that participating in HSNP does not seem to cushion households from the effects associated with weather shocks. Further, he finds evidence of extensive crowding out effects of private transfers especially when private transfers are received in non-cash forms. Finally, his thesis underscores the important role of HSNP in improving the consumption of nutritious diets amongst income poor households in Kenya.

Rugaimukamu, Kevin Mutayebwa Thesis Title: *The analysis of* determinants and barriers of household sustainable energy transitions in Tanzania

Kevin Rugaimukamu holds a BA in Economics and Statistics and an MA in Economics from the University of Dar es Salaam, Tanzania. He is an Assistant Lecturer in the Department of Economic Studies at the Mwalimu Nyerere Memorial Academy in Tanzania.

Kevin Rugaimukamu's thesis examines the economics of household energy transitions in Tanzania. Firstly, he studies the role of social capital in household's adoption of modern cooking fuels using panel data techniques and confirms the importance of social capital in household energy transitions. Secondly, he examines the impact of household energy transitions on household welfare using propensity score matching techniques, and the health and schooling impacts of such transitions. Finally, he identifies institutional barriers to rural electrification in Tanzania, including the meddling of the political clergy in the sector, deficiencies in the rules and regulations, and inherent institutional weakness. The findings of this thesis are that household energy transitions have positive welfare effects on households and that social capital may go a long away in enabling household energy transition through financial inclusion of the poor.
